Three Months training Course on “Care of Paintings”.

National Museum is organizing three-months intensive training course on “**Care of Paintings**”. The course shall start from 16th November 2009 to 15th February 2010. The aim of training is to impart theoretical and practical training in the field of Conservation of all types of Paintings.

Candidates from Art Academies, Departments of Archaeology, Museums, Archives, and allied institutions and practicing conservators from all over India shall be preferred. The basic qualification is graduate, preferably in science with one year experience in the field of art conservation. Ten candidates shall be selected on the basis of merit. Suitable scholarship shall be awarded to deserving candidates.
