

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE 33RD SHORT-TERM IN-SERVICE TRAINING
COURSE IN MUSEOLOGY IN THE NATIONAL MUSEUM, NEW DELHI.

The National Museum runs every year a regular short-term In-service Course in Museology. Admission is limited to 25 trainees from different recognised museums in India. In addition to those sponsored by the National Museum itself amongst the members of its staff. Names of candidates for training should be recommended by the respective authority through proper channel. The selection will, however, be made by the National Museum on the basis of the qualifications, experience, etc., as laid down in para 2 below.

- (1) **Duration and Scope:** The course is of short duration of six week (forty two days) and is meant to practical training in Museology so far as techniques and knowledge of museum profession and administration is concerned in subjects applicable to the fields included in the National Museum viz. Art, Archaeology and Anthropology together with the requisite theoretical training in general museology.
- (2) **Qualification:** At least post - graduate or equivalent degree in any subject included in Indian Museums with two to three minimum practical experience in a museum. Those in the Curatorial / Educational side and with higher qualifications and experience will be given preference.
- (3) **Conditions:**
 - (a) The trainee will not be entitled to get any TA/DA for joining the course in the National Museum and for return journey to him/her institution.
 - (b) A trainee will be liable to be reverted to his/her parent institution as a result of absence without leave or for any other delinquency or misconduct. The National Museum will be the sole authority in disciplinary matters.
 - (c) Selected candidates will be required to report themselves for training at the National Museum at 10.00 a.m. on the 17th February, 2006.
- (4) The applications complete in all respect and duly forwarded by the respective departments should reach to the Director (Collection & Administration), National Museum, Janpath, New Delhi - 110011 on or before the 25th January, 2006. No correspondence will be done with the candidates not selected for the training. The selected candidate will be informed telegraphically on 1st February, 2006.
- (5) The candidates will have to make their own arrangements of food, stay and transport in New Delhi. Delhi will be fairly cold during January-February. Candidates are, therefore, advised to bring adequate woollen garments for the same.
- (6) **Examination:** An examination/dissertation will be held at the end of the course and the successful trainees will be awarded certificates. Candidates obtaining less than 50% of the minimum marks in the examination or dissertation will not qualify for certificate.
